
## **Summary**

This screen can be used to assist with counting stock in Practice. Users can enter the value of the most recent stock take/count into Merlin, the Stock Variance report will then show any differences.


## **Details**

## **Using the Stock Variance Tool**


1. Navigate to **Utilities > Stock Control** and select the 'Stock Variance' tab.



- 2. Ensure you have selected the correct supplier from the drop-down list (this will default to your main supplier).
- 3. Select a treatment type from the left-hand menu, or use the 'Description' box.
- 4. Stock is displayed. This can be filtered using the fields provided.




5. Select 'Run' to apply any filters.



- 6. Enter the current stock levels (taken from the stock count) into the 'Available on Shelf' column for all items.
- 7. Select the 'Save' button once complete.

8. The next step is to produce a Stock Variance report, Select the 'Variance Report' button.



9. A report is generated in PDF format displaying Merlin's Stock level and the amount entered into 'Available on Shelf'.
