
There are two types of manual treatment you can add to a Patient's Treatment History:

Manual Treatment - With Prices


- 1. Enter the 'Add Treatment' screen (Treatment > 'Add Treatment' tab).
- 2. Select the 'Manual' button on the Treatment Screen toolbar.
- 3. Select 'With Prices'



4. The 'Add Manual Treatment' window will appear.




- 5. Enter a description for the treatment in the 'Description' box.
- 6. Enter pricing information (Gross, Qty, VAT).
- 7. Select a Clinical Code/Treatment Group/Surgeon.
- 8. Select 'OK' to add the treatment to draft.




Manual Treatment - Without Prices

- 1. Enter the 'Add Treatment' screen (Treatment > 'Add Treatment' tab).
- 2. Select the 'Manual' button on the Treatment Screen toolbar.
- 3. Select 'Without Prices'.



4. The 'Add Free-Text Treatment' window will appear



- 5. Enter a **description** for the treatment.
- 6. Select a Clinical Code/Treatment Group/Surgeon.
- 7. Select '**OK**' to add the item to draft (with zero quantity and no value).
